

4 Days - 3 Nights

The sample itinerary described below is approximately like the itinerary your group will be following during your stay with WHITE STAR TOURS. However, the exact times, days, and destinations may vary for your group.

- **Day 1** Depart from your hometown and head south to beautiful **Savannah**, **Georgia**. After checking into your hotel, enjoy dinner at a local restaurant.
- Day 2 After breakfast, travel to Savannah's Visitor Center where you will meet your guide for a 2-hour tour of one of the largest restored National Historic Landmark Districts in the nation. You will see 2.2 square miles of the Historic District showing over 270 years of rich history with its restored 18th and 19th century buildings and the waterfront where cotton warehouses are now restaurants, hotels, and shops. This beautiful city eloquently displays exquisite ironwork, ancient cobblestones, splendid mansions and picturesque cottages. You will see and hear about Factors Walk, Trustees Garden, City Market, and Colonial Cemetery. In the afternoon, visit the Savannah History Museum, housed in the old Central of Georgia Railway passenger shed and dating to the 1850s. The museum is now home to more than 10,000 artifacts including Forest Gump's bench, one of Johnny Mercer's Oscar Awards, and a carriage owned by the family of Girl Scouts founder, Juliette Gordon Lowe. You may also enjoy a film presentation of "Savannah the Survivor" in the theatre. A stop at Savannah's River Street District will allow you time to browse the unique shops and enjoy dinner on your own at one of the fine restaurants. Your day will end with a Ghosts & Gravestones Trolley Tour of Savannah ... a unique way to see Savannah and explore the dark side of its history.
- Enjoy breakfast, then depart for a visit to the Mercer-Williams House, immortalized in the book, Midnight In The Garden Of Good & Evil. Built for Civil War General Hugh W. Mercer, great grandfather of songwriter and lyricist Johnny Mercer, the house would never be home to any of the Mercer family. Construction began in 1860, but completion was delayed due to the outbreak of the Civil War, and it was not completed until 1869. Enjoy lunch on your own in Savannah's Old City Market area where you will find a wide array of restaurants and shops in the location that has been the hub of the city's social and business activity for centuries. Start your evening off with a delicious Southern family-style dinner at Food Network personality, Paula Deen's The Lady & Sons Restaurant. After the meal, continue to the historic Savannah Theatre for a fantastic Musical Revue Show. Enjoy an exciting 2 hours packed with music, dancing, comedy and more. The theatre first opened its doors in 1818. After a fire in 1948,; the theatre was remodeled to its current art deco style and re-opened in 1950.
- **Day 4** Following breakfast, check out and prepare for your departure home with fond memories of **Savannah, GA**.
